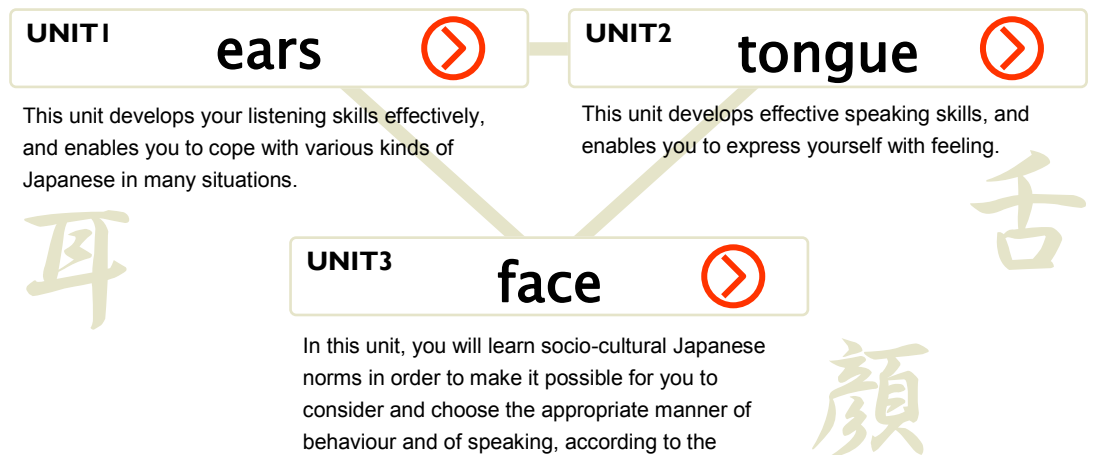

Introduction

IIEL

The Institute of International Education in London (IIEL), a British Graduate School, is an international education institute based in London. IIEL is dedicated to examining education in its essential form from the point of view of international education, and to the pursuit of that essential form in theory and practice. Besides its own activities as the head office for The Council of Japanese Language Teaching (CJLT) and The Council of Anglo-Japanese Education and Culture, hosting the symposiums for these organisations and publishing their bulletins, IIEL also acts as the British National Examination Centre where GCSE and GCE-A/AS level exams are carried out. One of the activities in which IIEL is involved is teacher training. IIEL runs an MA in Language Learning and Japanese Language Teaching in cooperation with the University of Greenwich, as well as Postgraduate Diploma/Certificate courses in Teaching Japanese as a Foreign Language.

LLC

LLC is affiliated with IIEL, the Institute of International Education in London, and runs a Japanese and English department accredited by the British Council. LLC promotes both Japanese and English language education and has forged strong links with many institutes in the UK. In order to promote Japanese language education in Japan, LLC has set up LLC Japan and has also undertaken joint projects with ICJ International Education Information Centre, together with whom we now introduce a new Japanese course.

ICJ

The International Education Information Centre of ICJ acts as the Japanese office of IIEL. ICJ carries out research on international education in Japan and also hosts the International Education Forum, bringing together professors and specialists from fields of Japanese language teaching, linguistics and pedagogy. This programme is run by ICJ under the sponsorship of LLC.
